

Runners warm up for Bayer 10K

HUNDREDS of runners are set to pound the town's streets on Sunday at the sell-out Bayer Newbury 10K race.

After the success of the inaugural run last year organisers promised to make it an annual event and all the places were filled within weeks of the entries opening.

The race, which will be started at 10am by Newbury explorer Lee Farmer, will again benefit the Kingsclere-based Sail 4 Cancer charity.

The race will start and finish in Newbury's Market Place. There will be a number of road closures in place from 9.45am on Sunday while the race is run.
